Houston Jaguars hand Out West a loss

In the first 20 minutes Out West was plagued by low percentage shooting and 18 turnovers. The Jaguars, on the other hand, played with precision both offensively and defensively. At the end of the half, the Jaguars were ahead by 30 points.

In the second half Out West performed more in keeping with their normal style of play decreasing their errors and improving on their shooting percentages.
